The amendments to the Rehabilitation of Offenders Act 1974 (Exceptions) Order 1975 (2013 and 2020) provides that when applying for certain jobs and activities, certain convictions and cautions are considered 'protected'. DBS Check

By law everyone living and working with vulnerable adults must have a current UK Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS) certificate, also known as a 'police check'.
